It is the goal of the Vocal Music Department to provide students with a comprehensive education full of performance experiences that promote life-long singing and appreciation.

5th Grade Choir Description

5th Grade students have the option to participate in a choral ensemble, in which they will learn beginning choral techniques. Students will have the opportunity to sing a variety of choral literature during the school year. Students will have formal performance opportunities to celebrate their skills and talents with the community. **This course does not formally report out on student progress.**

- explore music of different historical periods and cultures
- evaluate and respond to musical performances
- create and share original musical ideas
