Important Dates

- Aug. 15 - Teacher assignments and class schedules will be available on PowerSchool
- Aug. 21 - K-12 Open Houses and Sophomore New Student Orientation
- Aug. 22 - Required textbook fees will be added to student accounts in PowerSchool
- Aug. 23 - First day of school (K-12)
- Aug. 31 - Preschool Open House
- Sept. 1 - No school (teacher work day)
- Sept. 4 - No school (Labor Day)
- Sept. 5 - First day of preschool
