

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I sign my child up for bus services or make changes to my original registration? (Transportation requests are also included in the online registration process.)

- Please us Bussing and Walk Zone information to determine eligibility and if fees are applicable.
- Go to https://www.waukeeschools.org/
- Under "Departments" click on "Transportation" click on "Transportation Request Form"
- In the drop down, select the appropriate action.
- After completing the form, it is then electronically submitted to Durham School Services for processing. You will not receive any communication from Durham until approximately one week before school begins.
- **Please note:** This form will not be available until Returning Student Registration is opened on or about July 24th for the 2023-2024 school year.

Bussing and Walk Zone Information

Busing and applicable fees are determined by your **primary home address**.

- Elementary: more than 1 mile from the school = free
- Secondary: more than 2 miles from the school = free
- Walk-Zones will be defined as:
 - Elementary Schools living less than (.76 miles)
 - Secondary Schools grades 6-12 living less than (1.01 mile)
- Within these walk-zones, students will not be allowed to pay to ride.
- Distances are calculated in accordance with board policy.
- Please refer to Board Policy: 702.2: Student Eligibility for Transportation and 702.2-R(1): Student Eligibility for Transportation

Pay-To-Ride:

- Kindergarten through fifth grade students who live between .76 .99 miles from their designated attendance center may pay to ride District-provided transportation.
- Sixth through twelfth grade students who live between 1.01 1.99 from their designated attendance center may pay to ride District-provided transportation.

Fees

- \$625.00 per year, round trip, per child
- \$312.50 per year, one-way, per child
- Fees will be assessed within the 1st quarter of school for the 1st Semester
- Fees will be assessed within the 3rd quarter of school for the 2nd Semester
- *Pay to Ride Fees are non-refundable

What time and where is the bus stop?

- All bus information will be found in PowerSchool under Transportation.
 - **Please note:** This information will not be available until approximately one week before the first day of school, or approximately 24 hours after your request has been processed by Durham during the school year.
- Typical stop times are between 8:00 am and 8:25 am.

Will my child's bus stop be at my driveway?

• Unfortunately, due to District growth, all bus stops are community bus stops unless the student is assigned to a Special Needs route.

Do I have to be at the bus stop with my Kindergartner morning and afternoon?

- Yes, it is Durham School Services policy that a parent or older sibling is present at the bus stop to receive Kindergarten students.
- You may also appoint an older sibling, adult neighbor, grandparent, etc to receive your child from the bus in the afternoon.
- If you have a specific request, please feel free to contact Durham School Services to note on your child's profile.

Who do I need to call if my child will not be riding the bus in the morning and or afternoon?

• It is not required to call if your child will not be riding; however, we do appreciate the notification when possible. Please call 515.987.2788 in these circumstances.

Due to the adjusted schedule on the first two days of school, will my child be able to ride the bus?

- The buses will run one hour late and approximately two hours early on the first two days of school. If the bus time you are assigned is 8:20 am, the bus will be at the stop at 9:20 am in the morning. In the afternoon, if your assigned time is 4:00 pm, the bus will be arriving at approximately 2:00 or shortly before.
- We highly encourage the Kindergartners ride the bus on these two days to get them acclimated to riding the bus. You may also meet the bus at the school upon arrival if you are more comfortable.

How do I request my child to ride home with another child?

• Due to bus capacities, your child may only ride his or her assigned route bus.

How do I know if my child's bus is delayed morning or afternoon?

• Please be sure to register for Parent Square through the school district. Durham School Services will send out late bus notifications via Parent Square any time a bus is delayed by 10 minutes or more.
