Priorities for the Boundary Study

- Guided by significant feedback from the community, staff members, and students last fall/winter - three priorities emerged for this process:
 - Create and maintain a feeder for our grades 6-8, 9, 10-12 buildings with long-term sustainability
 - Balance our elementary schools in terms of class size, anticipated enrollment, and student demographics to the extent possible
 - Balance the WHS/WNWHS feeder systems with the same considerations
- Because this process is likely to create some areas of significant change, there will be a single, best map generated for Board review
- Student Exceptions, if any

100,000 Foot Perspective

An overview of what is most notable for your school district, students, and community. The 2022/23 Enrollment Analysis was updated in January 2023 with the BOE approved Middle School Boundaries and grade configuration.



District enrollment forecasted to increase by about 2,600 students to be 15,300 students by 2027/28

- Elementary forecasted to increase by about 1,200 students and enroll 7,300 total ES students
- Middle School forecasted to increase by about 700 students and enroll 4,600 total MS students
- High School forecasted to increase by almost 630 students and enroll 3,300 total HS students



New facilities are planned to address capacity concerns:

- o Waterford Elementary (ES #11) boundary to be decided
- Waukee North Middle School
- o Trailridge School



Development activity continues to be a main driver in enrollment increases


- o 779 SF and 513 MF units were built in 2022
- Almost 20,000 total potential units could be added to the district in the next ten years
- o Most growth is located to the northern areas of district

Main Takeaway: Waukee Middle School is forecasted over capacity over the next five years. Waukee North Middle and Waukee Northwest High school are forecasted to see challenged in 2028/29. A middle school boundary adjustment is needed to balance enrollment between facilities.





Areas of Separated Feeder: (see areas labeled #1 & #2)

- 1. Waukee feeder separation:
 - East of 10th St and north of University Ave goes to Waukee MS and Waukee Northwest HS
 - West of 10th St and south of University Ave goes to Timberline MS and Waukee HS
- 2. Maple Grove:
 - West of Grand Prairie Pkwy goes to Timberline MS
 - East of Grand Prairie Pkwy goes to Waukee South MS



Waukee Exception Recommendation (Areas in orange and black stripes):


- 6th to 11th grade students (all) are eligible for exceptions to continue at Waukee Northwest High School
- 5th grade students that are youngest family member are eligible for exceptions to continue at Waukee Middle School and continue to Waukee Northwest High School

Grant Ragan/Shuler Exception Recommendation: (Areas in yellow and black hatching)

 5th to 7th grade students (all) are eligible for exceptions to continue at Trailridge

Recommended Proposal: Projection Tables

Main Takeaway:

- Waterford ES comes online and increased from 55% to 70% utilization
- Walnut Hills ES decreases from 87% to 76% utilization
- Radiant ES increased from 38% to 90% utilization
- Secondary enrollment is distributed between facilities – Middle School facility plan will most likely need to be revisited after 2028/29
- High School enrollment will balance out by 2029/30 as students eligible for the exception policy work their way through

Main Takeaway:

Elementary schools are less balanced with Waukee and Woodland Hills ES at 99% utilization in the final year.

Secondary enrollment is well balanced at each level for the middle schools and high schools for the first few years.

- Radiant is the highest impacted school with over 500 students being reassigned to Grant Ragan ES, Shuler ES, Walnut Hills ES, and Waterford ES
- There are double moves in this concept (Walnut Hills) students are moved out of a boundary to move other students in

Recommended Proposal works on relieving Radiant Elementary and not impacting schools in the south until the next elementary comes online (Waukee).
