NWHS AND WHS MERGE

On April 1st, 2024, the Waukee School District held an emergency board meeting where they announced that Waukee and Waukee Northwest would be merging back together to avoid the financial troubles the district has been experiencing. To avoid bankruptcy, students will return to Waukee High School and Waukee Northwest High School will shut down. This news has shocked students, parents and staff. The board also introduced new ways to cut spending, including cutting back on the amount of school lunches purchased by the district and ending the lease on all school-provided technology.

The decision was based on how the district operated before the Waukee School District split into Waukee and Waukee Northwest. One student conveyed his disapproval of the decision.

He said, "I already have some trouble navigating the halls at Waukee, and with all of these new kids coming from Northwest, I think that will just amplify the problem."

Teachers at Northwest High School will keep their positions at Waukee High School to accommodate the teacher-to-student ratio required by the district. New plans for



Considering this group of people is odd enough to be seen together after their split up in 2018, it definitely threw lots


of people off. Stirring up the question are they actually reunited or is something else going on behind the scenes?

URBANDALE TO BE WAUKEE'S THIRD HIGH SCHOOL

This just in, Waukee Community School District has acquired the Urbandale School District to act as its third high school. This deal was announced this Thursday morning at 10:45 after a city council meeting between the two cities and other parties. 
thrown it against the wall three times now and it still works," described Northwest sophomore Dennis Menis, who was in the test group for LeapPads.

NORTHWEST'S MEAL MASHUPS

Beginning in term four for the 2023-2024 school year, the WCSD School Board has decided to implement a "new and improved" menu for the school cafeteria. The new menu will include nutrition-packed meals from across the globe, hoping students will try new foods and find a love for healthy eating.

"We want students to be able to experience foods different from those that they are used to eating in the past," said Makeen Grub, head of the WCSD nutrition department.

Grub announced she is excited to be still able to offer at least one vegetarian option each day, as well as two to three vitamin and mineral-packed side dishes to accompany each meal. It is not just the head of the nutrition department that helped make these changes, but all of the cooks in the cafeteria have been hard at work preparing these meals as well.

"Yeah they gave us different food to make so we just prepared what they asked us to, I didn't really ask many questions," stated cafeteria worker Grate Cook. "Personally I thought some of it was kind of funky, but it's not my place to say."

Though there have been some varying opinions within the kitchen of this new menu, overall these changes have been received with positive feedback.

Professional nutritionist Lotsa Prohteen discussed the nutrition changes in the menu and how these changes will help students in the long run.

"It may not seem like it at first glance, but when you really analyze and research the macros in each meal, one can see how the benefits stack up. The extra protein, fiber and vitamins will boost students' brain power by at least 200%. Teachers should expect their students to be up to 300% more productive after consuming these meals."

Each new breakfast meal will contain at least 75 grams of protein and each lunch option contains 150 grams of protein at a minimum. Exceptions from this include the vegetarian breakfast and lunch options, which overall contain little to no beneficial nutrients.

The cafeteria has released the first two weeks' worth of meals and the breakfast menu for students and parents to review. Currently, any suggestions for changes or edits are not being accepted. Happy eating, Wolves!
